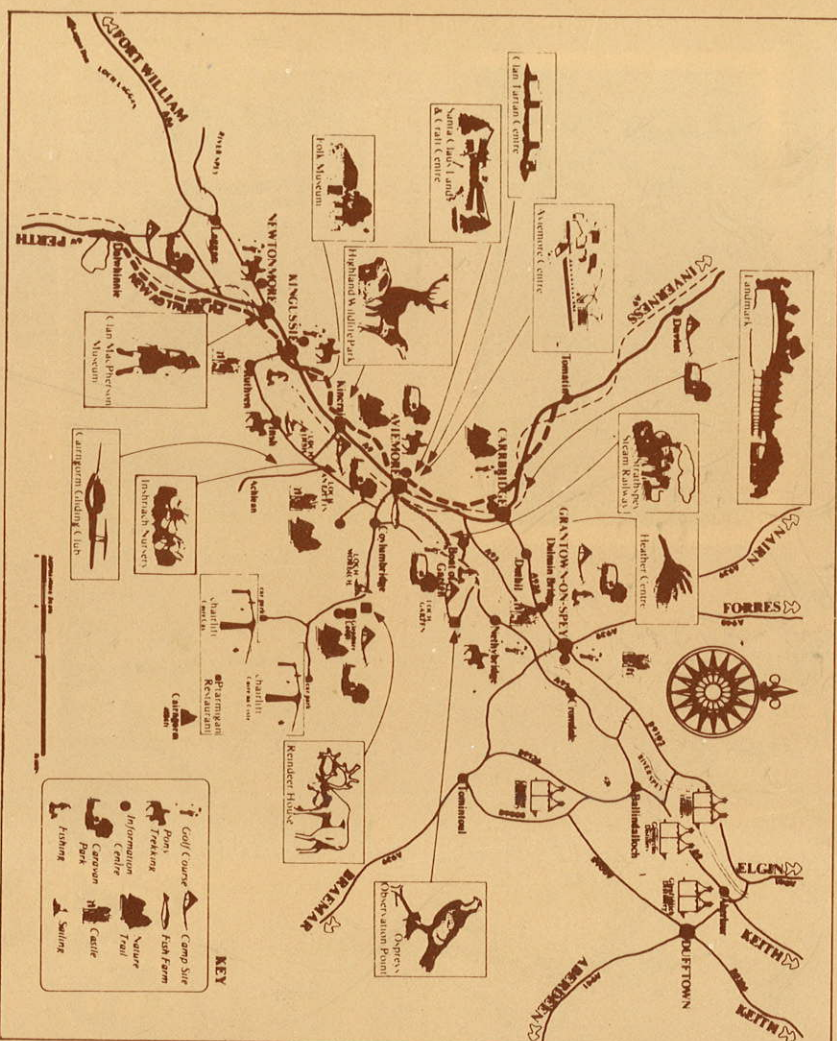


Spey Valley
